Testing for High 5's Challenge Course Managers' Certification is a written exam with a practical application component. To help the practitioner prepare for these tests, High 5 suggests that the following materials be reviewed or practiced prior to the certification test.

Written Exam

The written exam will contain a variety of Short Answer and Essay questions. The topics that are covered in the test match the required ACCT Certification Standards Testing Categories. Many of these topics are part of a typical challenge course managers' training such as High 5's three day workshop, Managing an Adventure Program. These categories are as follows:
